


The teacher's head turned bright red and Matthijsje said, "Yes, that's possible, but I meant chewing gum."

# Swiss Rolls



Hello Cuties!

As many of you might already know, I love baking. Some may even have tasted my creations before, others have only seen the pictures. While I myself am a big fan of recreating pastries from the world of patisserie, every once in a while I also want to make some simpler pastries that still offer a little challenge and where creativity can run wild. One of these simpler pastries with a challenge is the Swiss roll. The Swiss roll is an elegant, yet minimalistic pastry that can be infinitely varied in flavor and layout and is incredibly fun to make. Reasons enough to share the recipe with you!

## Pattern

- 60 grams of powdered sugar
- 60 grams of soft butter, unsalted
- 2 big egg whites
- 80 grams of flour, sifted
- Optional food colouring

In a separate bowl, mix the powdered sugar with the butter till the mixture is white and light. This takes at maximum 5 minutes with a handmixer. After that add the egg whites and mix for two more minutes. Then add the sifted flour and mix briefly until the batter is completely mixed.

The mixture now is ready for use. Would you rather have a different colour than white? Then it is best to choose a pow-

der or gel colouring. Add the desired colour and stir the mixture until the colour is evenly distributed. Rather a chocolate flavour and colour? Then replace 5-10 grams of flour with cocoa powder.

The cake will soon get a size of 23 by 33 cm, draw this size on a baking sheet and place the bottom on the baking tray.

Add the batter to a piping bag or a freezer bag and now pipe your desired pattern within this box onto your baking paper. You can either print out a pattern on paper and place it under the baking sheet and trace it or, as I like to do, just freehand. Pinterest is your best friend here if you need inspiration for the pattern! If you work with the paper, don't





forget to remove it before you put the cake in the oven. Make sure the opening of your nozzle or bag is the right size for the design you want to make.

Replace the baking paper with the pattern to the cutting board and put this in the freezer. Meanwhile, preheat the oven at 180°C on hot air, or 200°C lower and upper heat.

### Cake

- 70 grams melted butter, chilled
- 6 big eggs, split yolks and egg whites
- 200 grams (vanilla) sugar
- 120 grams flour, sifted
- Pinch of salt
- Optional food colouring or cocoa powder

After the pattern is drawn, it is time to make the cake batter. Start by beating the egg whites in a fat-free (preferably stainless steel) bowl until weak peaks form. Gradually add half of the sugar and continue beating until stiff peaks form. In a different bowl, beat the egg yolk with the remaining sugar until light and double in volume. This could easily take 10 minutes with a hand mixer. The mixture will become much lighter in colour. When the volume is doubled, slowly add

the butter till it is mixed nicely. Then add a small portion of flour and gently stir it in. Then add the portion of egg white foam and alternate until everything is mixed together.

Lastly, add the optional gel or powder food colouring or replace part of the flour with cocoa powder to give a chocolate flavour. Make sure that you don't beat it too hard, you do of course want the mixture to remain airy.

Take the pattern out of the freezer and put this on the baking tray. Empty the batter over the pattern so it stays within the drawn box, if it goes a little over it is no problem, this can be trimmed later.

Put the cake in the oven for around 13-15 minutes, till the edges are gold brown.

When the cake is done, you have to work quickly: Remove the cake from the oven, sprinkle it with powdered sugar and place a new baking sheet on top. Turn the cake over and slowly remove the old baking paper. Place a new baking sheet on top of this, too. Turn the cake over again, remove the first baking sheet and roll it up slowly, starting with the long side. Wrap the rolled cake in a tea towel and leave to cool.

### White Chocolate Cream

- 250ml whipped cream
- 100 grams mascarpone
- 200 grams white chocolate
- 1 bag klopfix
- (Vanilla) sugar to taste

Chop the white chocolate and in the meantime, heat the cream in a pan until it just boils. Lower the heat and add the chocolate and sugar to taste to the mixture. When all the chocolate dissolved, turn off the heat and leave the mixture to cool till room temperature. Put the cream overnight in the fridge.

Take the cream out of the fridge the next day and whip it up. Add the mascarpone and the bag of klopfix to the mixture and beat it till the cream is stiff. The cream is ready for use.

### Caramelised Apples

- 2-3 small apples
- Cinnamon or Speculaas spices after taste
- Sugar to taste
- Optional custard powder

Peel the apples, remove the core and cut into small cubes. The smaller and finer the apples, the better they stand out in

This is one example of the many ideas that are possible with this type of cake. Take your inspiration from it and try out different taste evaluations! Another delightful combination is for example with passion fruit curd, mango pieces and white chocolate cream. One of the things I want to try is to get the Piranha logo on the cake. If this ever works out, the photo will of course be distributed quickly within the association!

Bake them and if there are any questions, feel free to ask!

the cake. Put the apples with 1-2 tablespoons of water in the fire and then add the cinnamon\spices and the sugar to taste. Start with a bit of sugar and gradually add more sugar depending on how you want your apples to be caramelised. The custard powder can be added if the apples contain too much moisture to caramelize. A little custard powder will bind the moisture and give you a nice firm sauce around your apples.

When the apples are caramelised sufficiently, they're ready for use. Leave them to cool till room temperature and use them immediately, or put them in the fridge till further use.

### Final Assembly

When all the elements are made, you can remove the cake slowly from the tea towel. Roll out the cake slightly, taking care not to break it, and fill it with the apples and cream. Make sure you do not use too much because then everything will come out of the cake. Slowly roll up the cake, decorate with icing sugar and dollops of whipped cream or apples and enjoy!

# Alternative goggles

Imagine, you arrive at the swimming pool and you realize... oops I forgot my swimming goggles again. It happens to everyone and unfortunately you have no other option, you have to train without it. However, we don't feel like doing that and thought that there would be other options. This page therefore contains a review of some improvised goggles so you can use the best alternative next time! At the time of testing, all swimming pools were closed due to corona. This is the reason why these tests are done at home. We will test and evaluate 4 alternatives based on waterproofness, visibility and comfort.



The first option is a swimming goggle made of plastic cups. You make the goggles by cutting the cups to the shape of your eyes. Then the cups are attached to each other with the help of adhesive tape.

Review: The plastic cups are higher than 10 cm, this is why these glasses are completely waterproof when tested

in a washing-up bowl. The vision is also relatively clear, however, the edges of the plastic are very sharp and we do not recommend wearing these glasses for an entire workout.

Our second option is a pair of swimming goggles made of bubble wrap. We all have enough of these in our homes due to the corona self-test packages and packages ordered online. The swimming goggles are made by cutting the bubble wrap into a goggle shape. The bubble plastic is attached to the head with lots of adhesive tape.

Review: These goggles would have been good, provided they are properly taped to the head. The vision is as expected very poor, but a good side effect is that if you collide due to the poor vision you are protected. The glasses are reasonably comfortable, except when removed.

The third option is swimming goggles made of plastic spoons. The plastic spoons are slightly bent with the help of a lighter to fit better around the head. The scoop parts of the spoons are attached to each other with a piece of adhesive tape. Tip: use two pieces of tape so that the tape doesn't stick to your nose and so that the glasses are more secure. The spoon backs are attached to each other with an elastic band so that they fit everyone. We admit we have no idea why you would want that, but it's a nice touch.

Review: The glasses are very fashionable, but we are not so positive about the waterproofing. The glasses are only waterproof when the eyes are squeezed very tightly. Visibility on the other hand, is very good due to the hard plastic. The comfort could be made better by using bigger spoons, but overall it fitted nicely.

The last option is made with a beautiful pair of piranha sunglasses. The idea is very simple, duct tape is attached to the edge of the sunglasses to ensure that

not all the water runs behind the glasses. Review: Sadly, this idea was not a success and all the water ran past it. Visibility was also disappointing, and not just because of the duct tape getting in the way. In terms of comfort, these were the best glasses, it was just like chilling with your regular sunglasses.

But I have to be honest, a job can be a lot of fun. You can face challenges that you would not easily encounter in your student days. Another advantage is money. You can do all sorts of things with it!


